There will be an opportunity for trainees for FFT2, FFT1, ENOP, ENGB and possibly STEN and FAL3. We would like to open the event up to 20 individuals and five type 6 and or type 3 engines and crew. There will be lodging available for participating staff; crews will be on-their- own for breakfast sack field lunch and dinner at the end of shift.

This event will run as an incident so participants will receive MOC resource orders and will interact with the components of RX burn team. We would like a commitment of a minimum of three days and will keep folks busy for the entire week should they be available. The week will run as Travel on Monday the 8th and release to travel to home unit on Friday 12th. If the weather is not in prescription for burning, we will have other projects that the crews will work on. We would like to have participants signed up by 1/4/18 so we can get the orders out on 1/5/18.
