S-230, CREW BOSS (SINGLE RESOURCE) (24 hrs.)

Class meets as follows: Thursday, 6:00 pm - 10:00 pm; Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm Saturday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm; Sunday, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm.

This is a classroom course designed to produce student proficiency in the performance of duties associated with the single resource boss position from initial dispatch through demobilization to the home unit. Topics include operational leadership, preparation and mobilization, assignment preparation, risk management, entrapment avoidance, safety and tactics, offline duties, demobilization, and post incident responsibilities. This Class Has Pre-course work

S-215, FIRE OPERATIONS IN THE WILDLAND/URBAN INTERFACE (24 hrs.)

Class meets as follows: Thursday, 6:00 pm - 10:00 pm; Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm Saturday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm; Sunday, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm.

Instructional units include firefighter safety in the interface, managing human factors in the interface, pre-incident planning, sizeup and initial strategy, structure triage, structure protection overview, tactics in the interface, tactical operations and resource use in the interface, action assessment, plan update, and after action review.

L-280, FOLLOWERSHIP TO LEADERSHIP (20 hrs.)

Class meets as follows: Friday, 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm; Saturday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm; Sunday, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm. This training course is designed as a self-assessment opportunity for individuals preparing to step into a leadership role. The course combines one day of classroom instruction followed by a second day in the field with students working through a series of problem solving events in small teams (Field Leadership Assessment Course). Topics include leadership values and principles, transition challenges for new leaders, situational leadership, team cohesion factors, ethical decision-making, and after action review techniques. Some course delivery may be arduous in nature. This Class Has Pre-course work

S-131, FIREFIGHTER TYPE 1 (8 hrs.)

Class meets as follows: Thursday, 6:00 pm – 10:00 pm; Friday, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm. This course is designed to be interactive in nature. It contains several tactical decision games designed to facilitate learning the objectives and class discussion. Topics include fireline reference materials, communications, and tactical decision-making.

S-133, LOOK UP, LOOK DOWN, LOOK AROUND (4 hrs.)

Class meets as follows: Saturday, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm

This course is designed to train Incident Commander Type 5 (ICT5) and Firefighter Type 1 (FFT1) to identify environmental factors and indicators of hazardous fire conditions, and how to use these indicators when implementing the Risk Management Process

RT-130 Annual Fireline Safety Refresher (4 hrs.)

Class meets as follows: Saturday, 1:00 am - 5:00 pm

Annual Fireline Safety Refresher Training should be designed to provide up to date Fireline safety information.

PPE--The following personal protective equipment will be required for field work in those courses identified; Hardhat, Nomex shirt & pants, leather boots, and a fire shelter. Nomex coveralls can be substituted for pant and shirt.
